Barriers to Weatherization in Rural Communities

Geographic

- Geographic isolation & dispersed population
- Lack of energy efficiency contractors

• Financial

- Upfront cost
- Lower incomes, higher energy burdens
- Credit access and debt aversion

Awareness & Access

- Lack of access to traditional marketing channels
- Lack of awareness or skepticism of existing resources
