

Data Across Sectors for Health (DASH): Hallowell, Maine



Hallowell's Demographics

- Hallowell's median age is 39.5 years old, which is five years younger than the median age for the state of Maine.
- Hallowell's under 18 population is about 21.1%, compared with 19% for Maine.
- People 60 or older make up 29% of the population in Hallowell, compared with 27% of the population in Maine.
- People 65 or older make up 22.9% of the population in Hallowell, compared with 19.4% for Maine.

Hallowell's Demographics

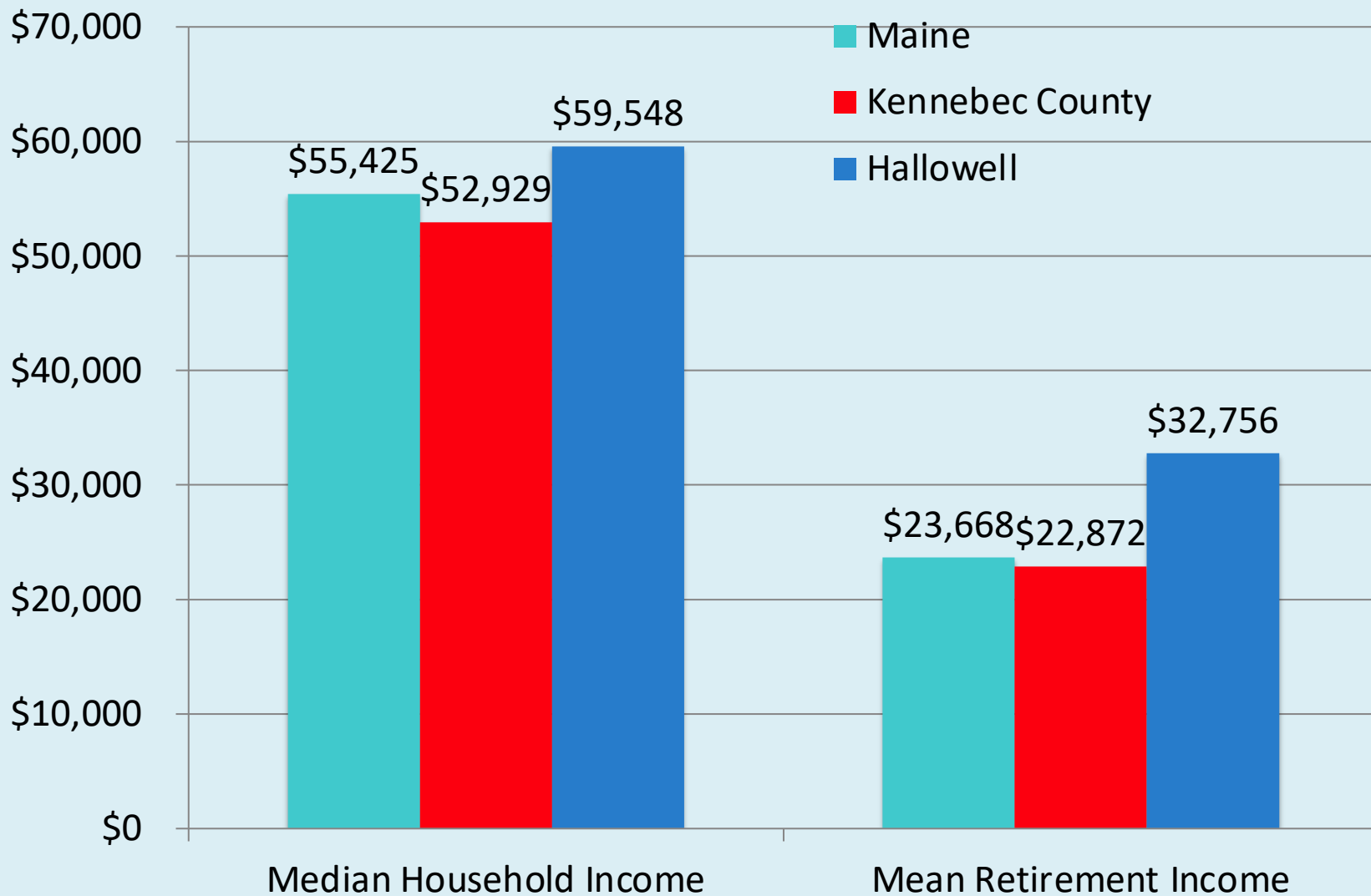
- 8.3% of the population in Hallowell are 70 to 79 years old, compared with 8% for Maine.
- 8.8% of the population in Hallowell are 80 or older, compared with 4.8% for Maine.

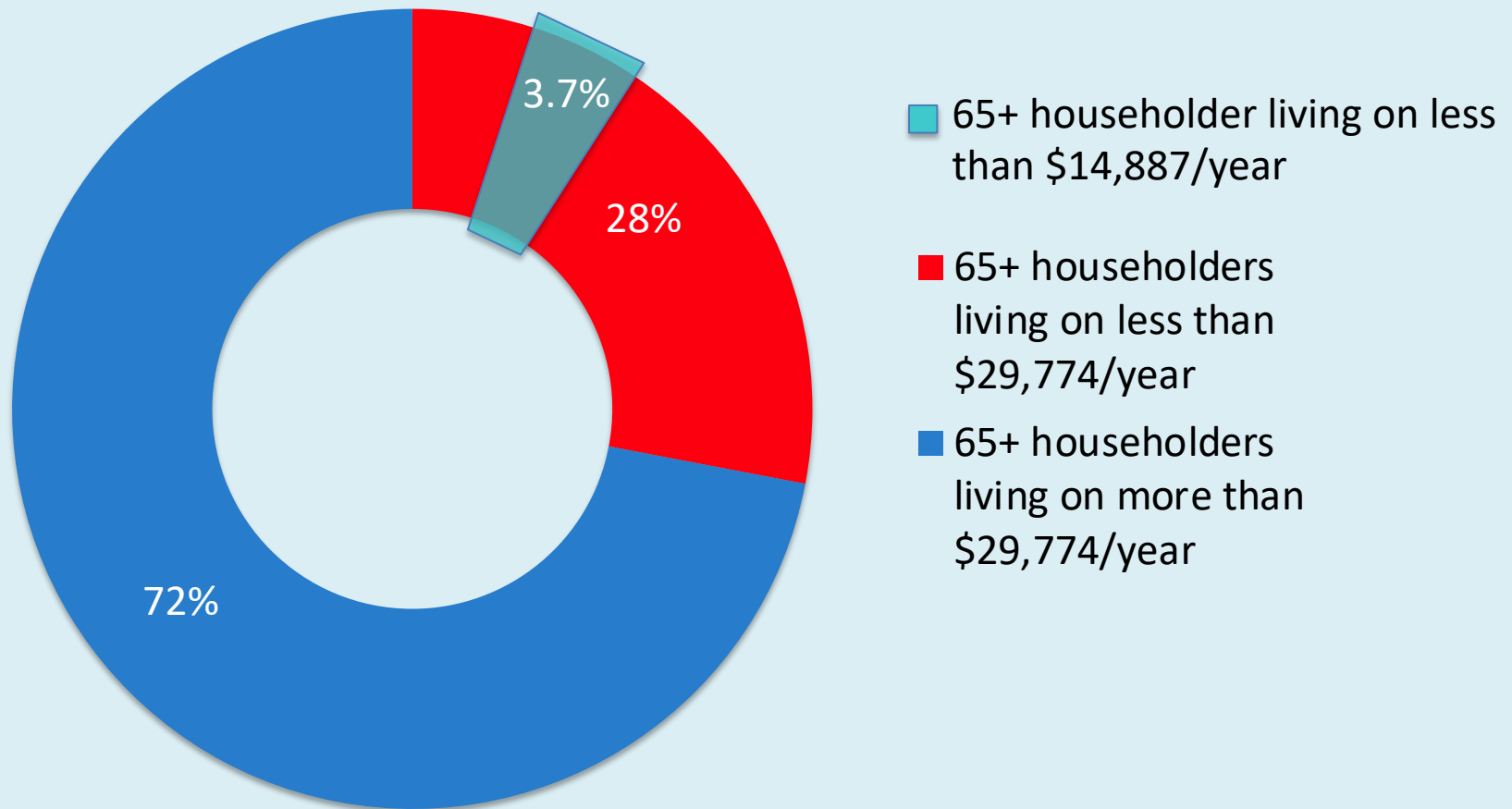

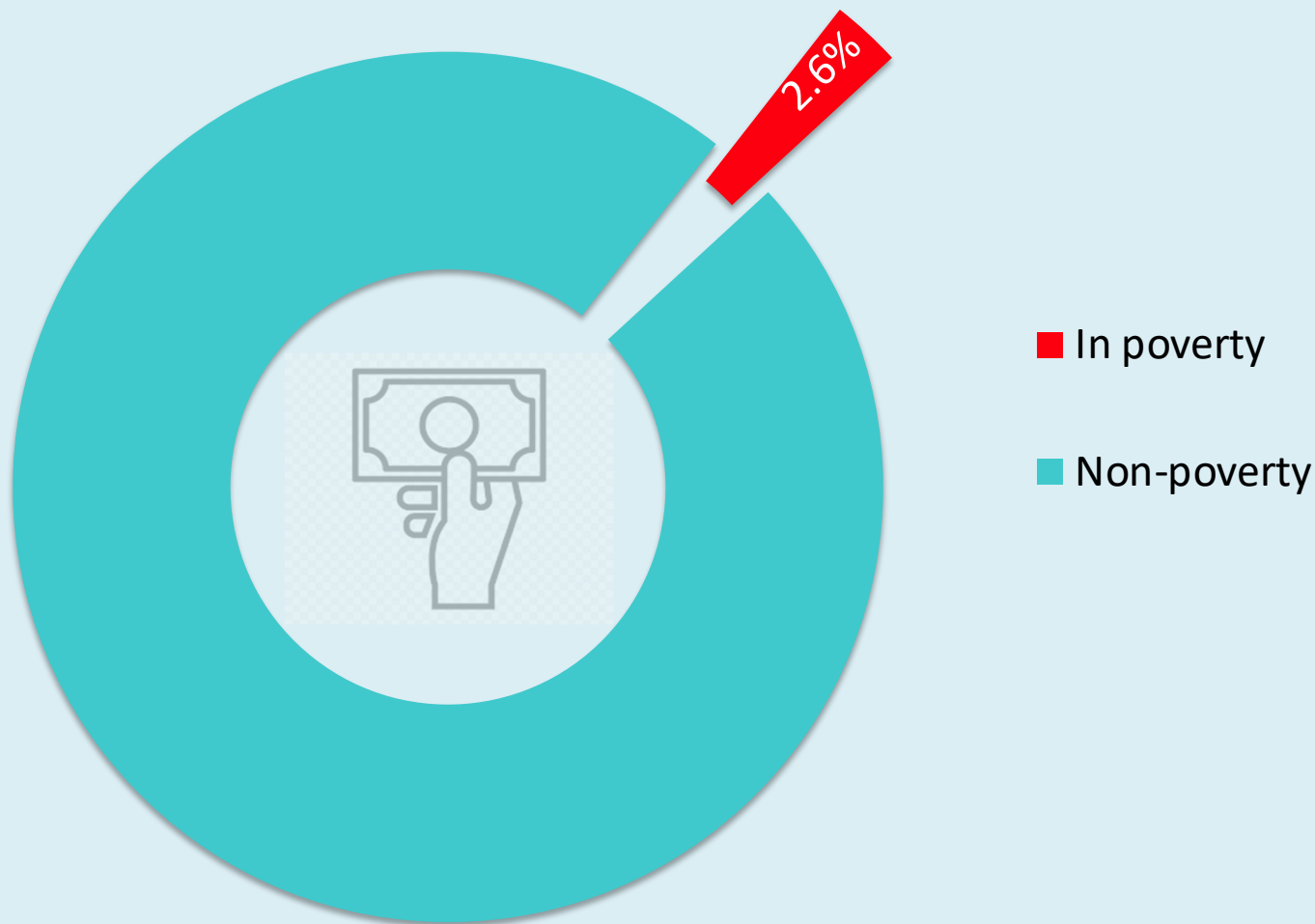


Poverty Status for Older People in Hallowell

65+ below Federal Poverty Line (\$12,140 for 2018)

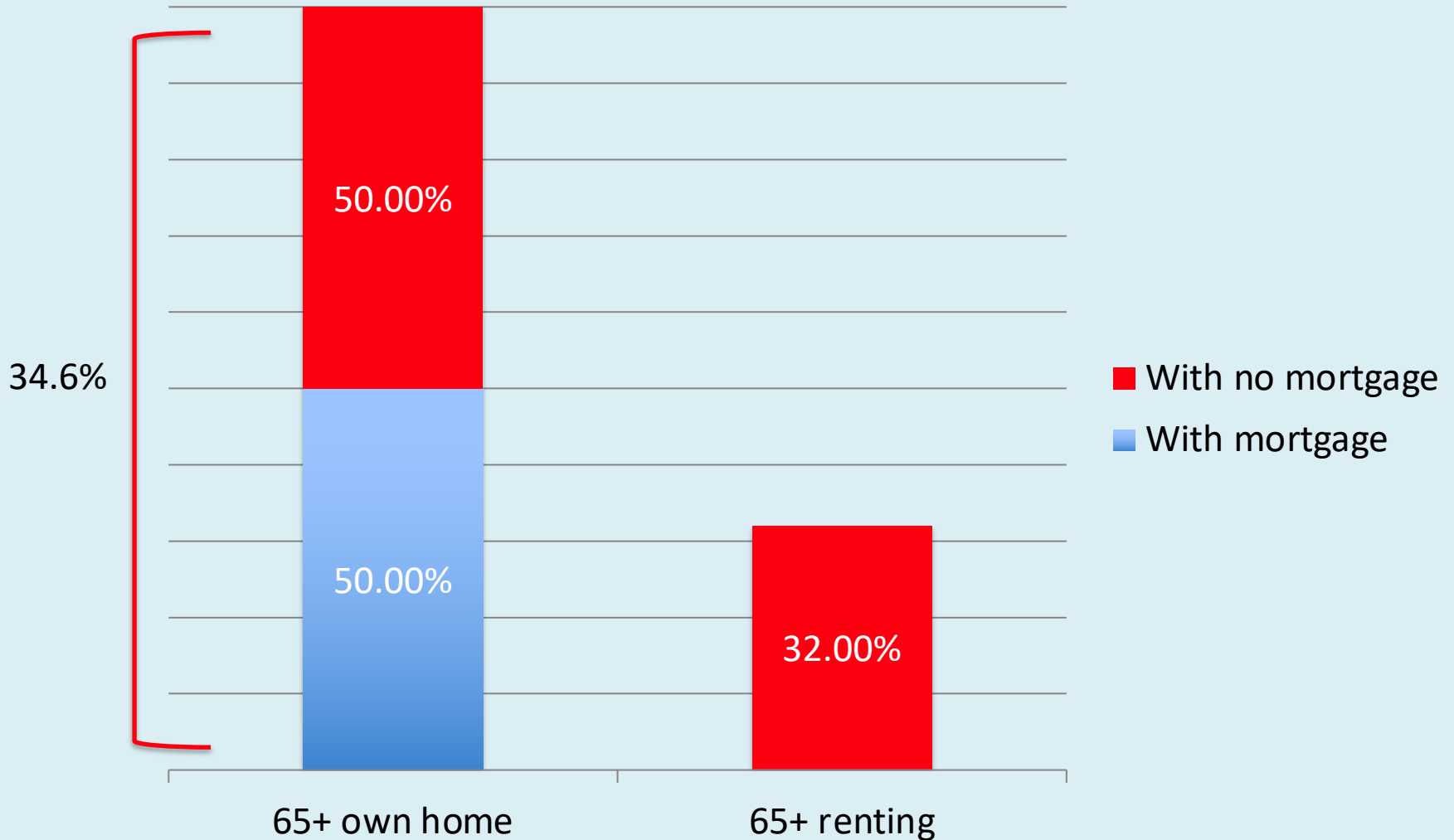

From 2017 to present, there were only 2 Accessory Dwelling Units constructed in Hallowell.

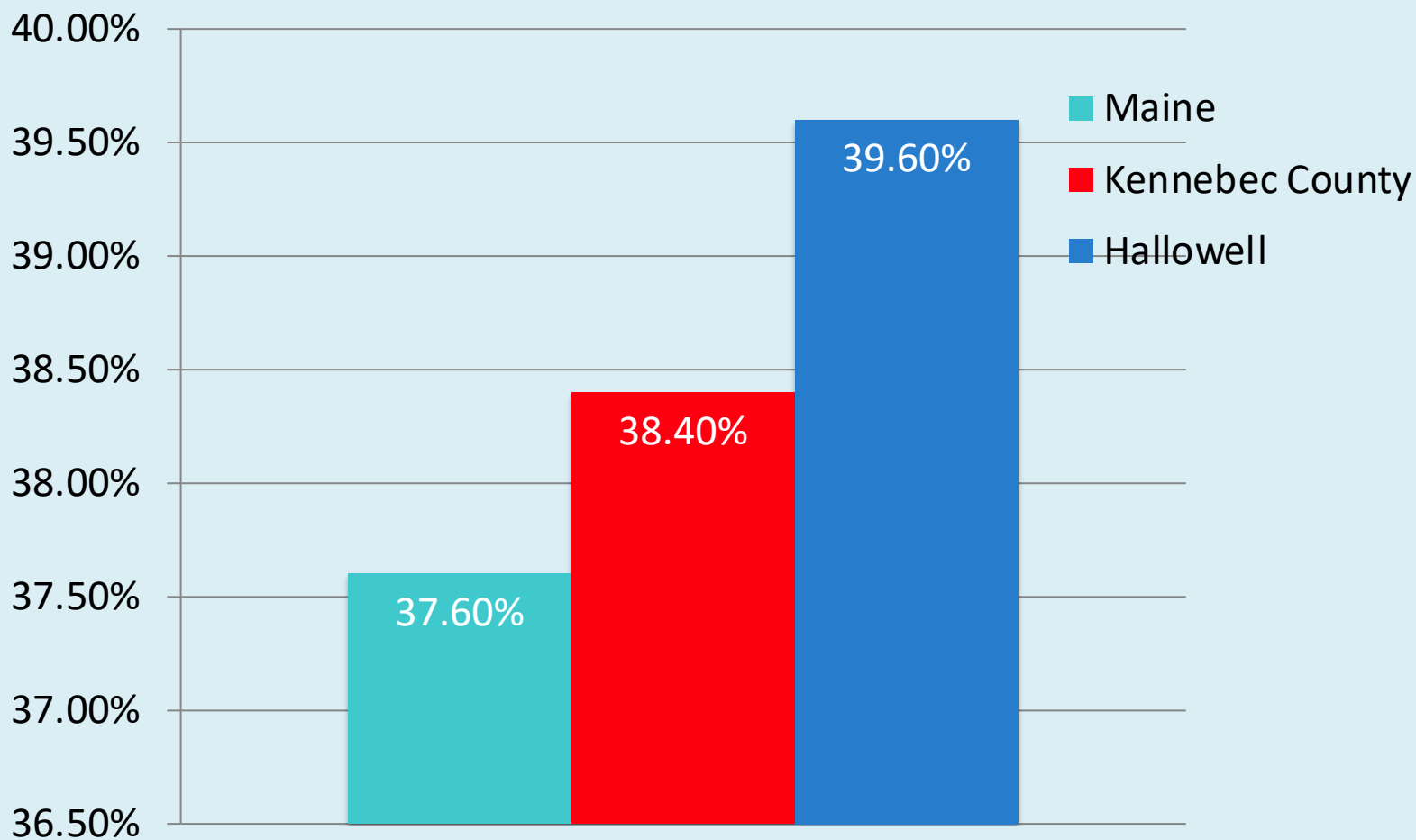


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SNAP Households in Hallowell with at least one person 60+

Hospitalizations, ED Visits, Advance Directives, Insurance

676 senior citizens from Hallowell had an encounter at an MGH location from 1/1/2019 to 2/28/2021. Of these, 167 (24.70%) had an advanced directive, 153 (22.63%) had at least one inpatient encounter, and 286 (42.31%) had at least one emergency visit. The breakdown of insurance is presented in Table 1.

304 Hallowell seniors are current MGH primary care patients. Within this population the number and percentile of individuals with one of 17 different chronic conditions is presented in Table 2.

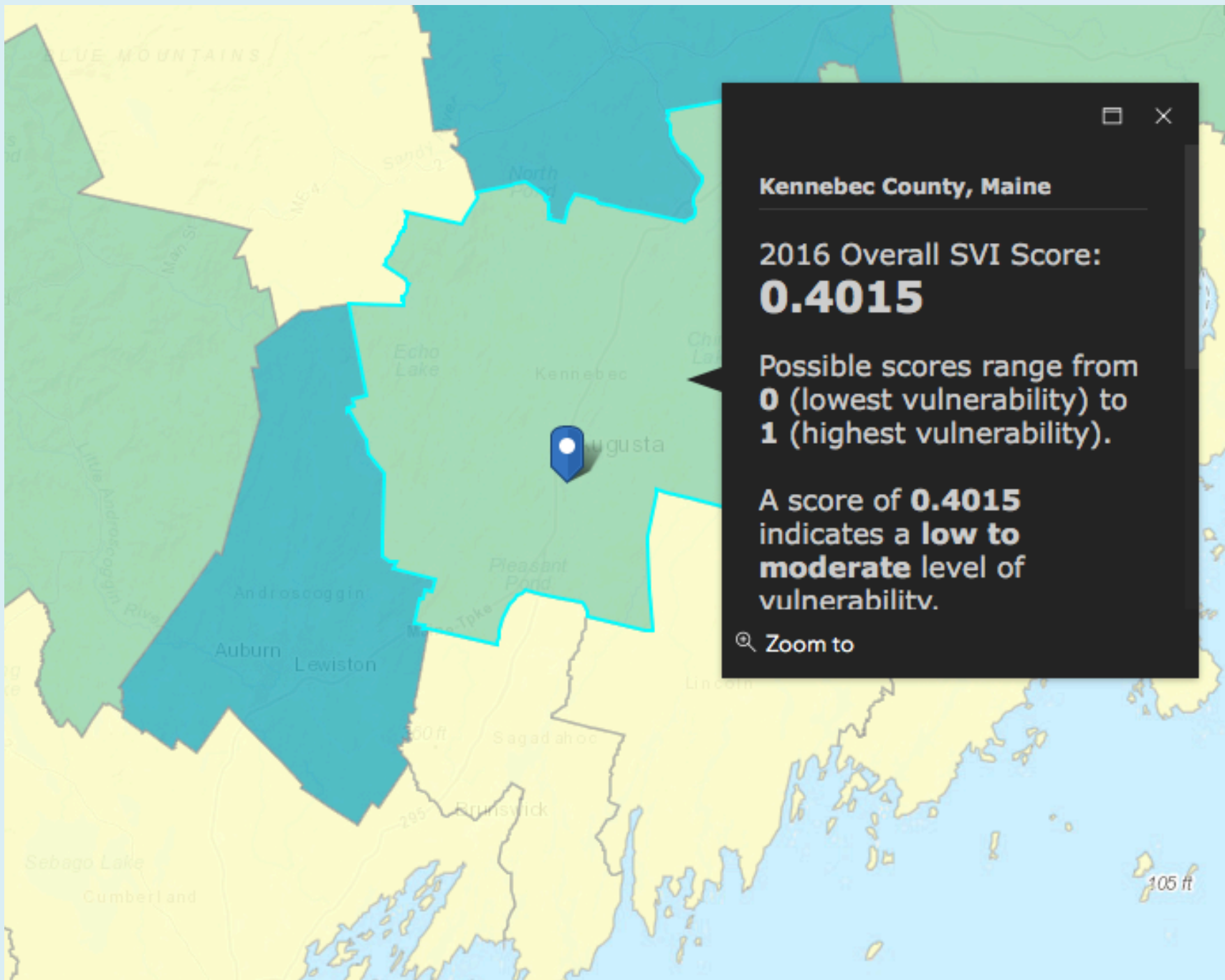

Social Vulnerability Index

What is Social Vulnerability?

Every community must prepare for and respond to hazardous events, whether a natural disaster like a tornado or disease outbreak, or a human-made event such as a harmful chemical spill. A number of factors, including poverty, lack of access to transportation, and crowded housing may weaken a community's ability to prevent human suffering and financial loss in a disaster. These factors are known as **social vulnerability**.





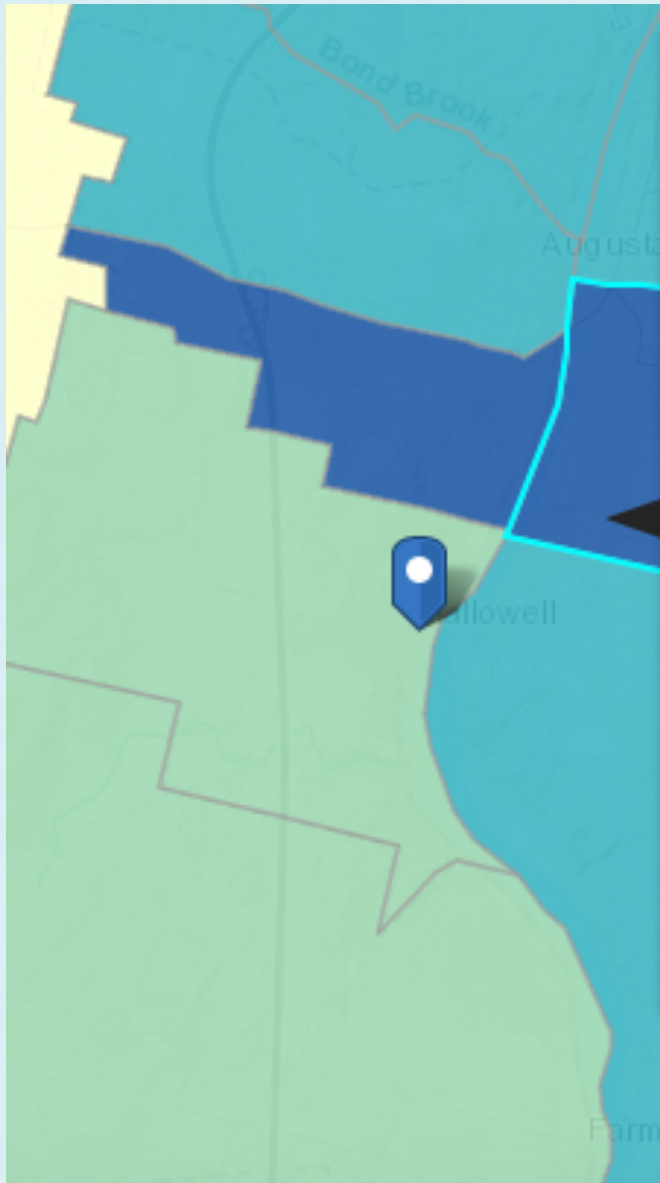

90–100	Walker's Paradise Daily errands do not require a car
70–89	Very Walkable Most errands can be accomplished on foot
50–69	Somewhat Walkable Some errands can be accomplished on foot
25–49	Car-Dependent Most errands require a car
0–24	Car-Dependent Almost all errands require a car

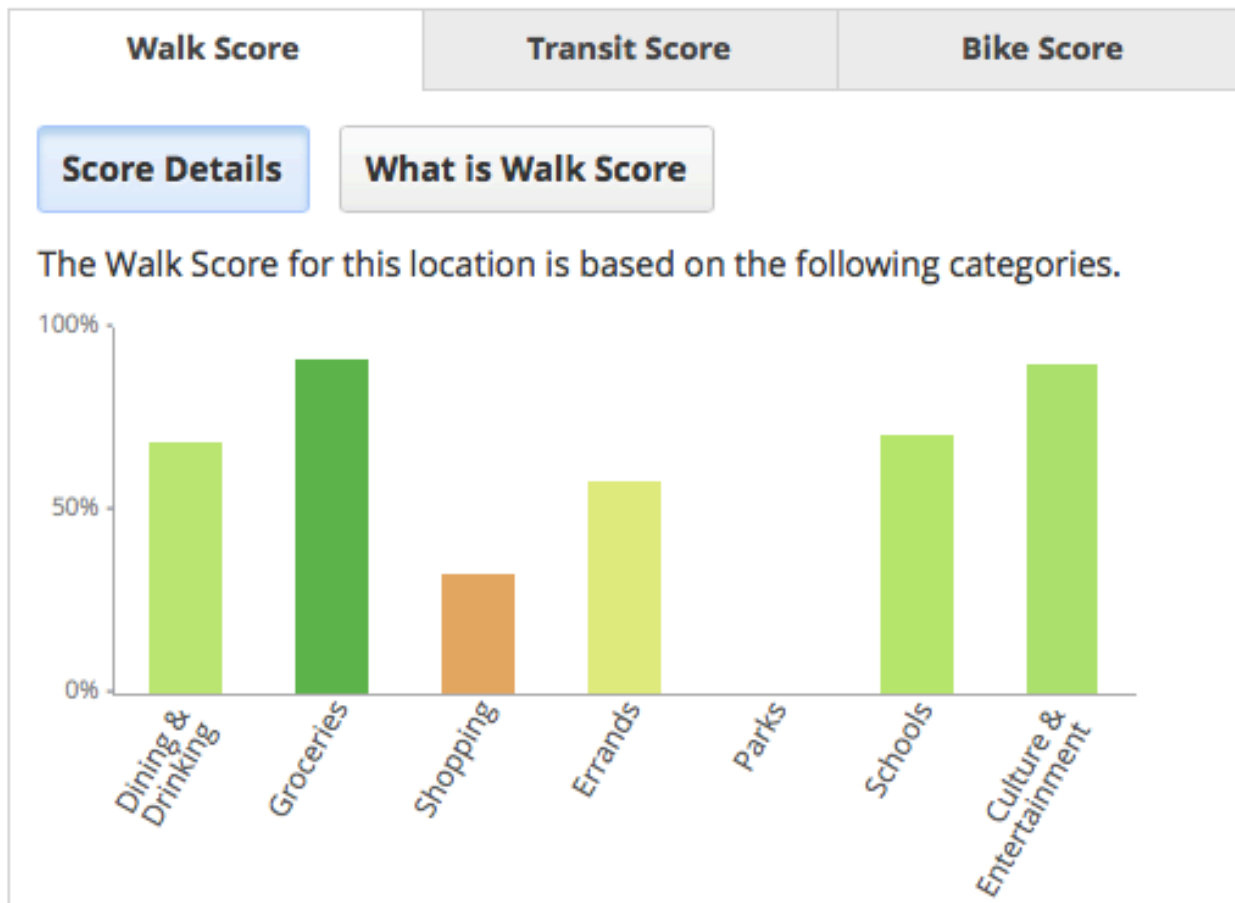
